



Understanding Detention Guidelines

Guideline Rationale:

To ensure the safety and well-being of all students and staff, as well as provide an educational environment where all students can achieve and succeed, it is essential that behaviour is monitored.

All staff, have a responsibility to promote positive behaviour, to encourage mutual respect and to instil self-discipline in students.

Where students do not respond positively to the standards and expectations of the school, it may, on occasions, be necessary to impose a fair, reasonable and proportionate sanction.

These guidelines must be read in conjunction with the Yeshiva Discipline Policy which maybe located from the Yeshiva College website <https://yeshivacollege.nsw.edu.au/>

The purpose of these guidelines is to inform parents and students how and when detention will take effect as a result of unacceptable behaviour.

Detention

Note: The length of time of a detention and Level of the detention being 1-2 is determined at the discretion of the Head of Boys/ Girls and the Principal of Yeshiva College.

1. Recess (7 minutes) or Lunchtime (20 minutes) – Level 1

Level 1 – Other Behaviours (First Occasion)

Disrespectful to teacher, Poor attitude towards class activities

Disrespectful to classmates, Excessive talking during class

Not completing homework

Failure to complete activities in class

Ongoing failure to follow teacher's instructions. (Out of seat without permission)

Damaging school property, Lack of self-control

Out of school uniform

Damaging classmates' property

Eating whilst in class

Arrival Late: 3 days in a row or 3 days in one week

Parents will receive an email from Yeshiva College outlining the misbehaviour and detention duration.

2. After School Detention (45 minutes) – Level 2.

Held one afternoon of the week at the Head of Girls/Boys discretion

Level 2 – Behaviours (second /multiple occasion at the discretion of the Teacher, maybe on referred to Principal based on severity and number of repeated unacceptable behaviour)

- all list in Level 1,
- Absent: 3 days in any week of term, without a note



Parents will receive an email from Yeshiva College outlining the misbehaviour and detention duration.

3. Evening After School Detention (60 minutes) Level 2

Issued by Principal where detentions need to be elevated eg; repeat offenders.

Parents will receive an email from Yeshiva College outlining the misbehaviour and detention duration.

4. Sunday After School Detention (60 minutes) Level 2

Issued by Principal where detentions need to be elevated eg; repeat offenders.

Parents will receive an email from Yeshiva College outlining the misbehaviour and detention duration.

5. Suspension from School

Issued by the Principal (all areas of management of behaviour have been exhausted)

Parents will receive an email from Yeshiva College outlining the misbehaviour and detention duration.
